

SS836 First Corinthians as Christian Theology

Description	This is an advanced seminar for STL students on the theological dimensions of 1 Corinthians. With the instructor's permission, it is open to CAS students and advanced MAT students in the E.I. The seminar will examine the letter for its contributions to theology proper (the doctrine of God), Christology, pneumatology, Trinitarian theology, ecclesiology, soteriology, eschatology (including the resurrection of the dead), sacramentology (baptism and Eucharist), and the theology of ministry, justice, human sexuality and marriage, love, and spiritual gifts. The seminar is scheduled to be held in person, but a virtual option may be possible. (<i>Note: the course number may change.</i>)
Requirements	Reading: major portions of three commentaries and the instructor's own commentary-in-progress; portions of other commentaries and books on reserve; selected articles and essays from a variety of sources; total, about 1,000 pages
	Writing: several short papers (2–4 pages) and one 20-page paper
