

Youth Theological Studies Pinkard Scholars Program

Congratulations, you have been **nominated to apply** for the fall ***Pinkard Scholars Program*** for High School Juniors as of this **fall 2026** at St. Mary's Seminary & University! This exciting opportunity consists of:

- A twelve-week theology course ***Religious Studies 235: Thinking Theologically: Christian Hope in Today's World.***
- in the fall of 2026 one Tuesday evening per week from 6:15 P.M. – 8:45 P.M.
- A ***Celebration of Excellence and Promise*** at which three college credits will be conferred if all requirements are met.

Tuition for each student is **\$350.00, which includes all texts**. The course is partially underwritten by the Pinkard Endowment and is open to students of all faiths. Please do not send payment with your application form. Once you have been accepted into the program, payment can be submitted.

Two full scholarships underwritten by the Mark D. Pacione Foundation. All scholarships are based on need. If you are accepted into the Pinkard Scholars program and would like to apply for a scholarship and are in need of scholarship funds, please request a *Scholarship Application and Award Form* once you have received your acceptance letter. You will be instructed to also include a description of why you are requesting the scholarship.
