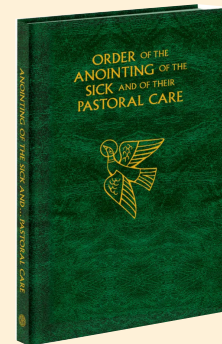


# Introducing the Order for the Anointing of the Sick and Their Pastoral Care
