Father John Fortin, OSB

Father John professed vows as a monk of Saint Anselm Abbey in 1970. He is the founding director of the Institute for Saint Anselm Studies at Saint Anselm College and is a professor in the Philosophy Department. He has published several books and articles in scholarly journals and has given presentations at professional conferences on medieval subjects. He also preaches retreats and days of recollection for clergy, religious communities, schools and parishes.

Academically, he earned degrees in philosophy, Great Books and medieval studies prior to his ordination to the priesthood in 1976.

Since 1981, he has served at Saint Anselm College in many capacities — Campus Ministry, Residential Life, Dean of Students, Governing Board and Board of Trustees.

He served on the Presbyteral Council and the Superintendent of Schools for the Diocese of Manchester.
