Known as one of the voices on The Liturgy Guys podcast, he also is author of *A Devotional Journey into the Mass* and *A Devotional Journey into the Easter Mystery* (Sophia), as well as *Principles of Sacred Liturgy: Forming a Sacramental Vision* (Hillenbrand Books).
